2012 Australian Amputee Golf Open Tournament Information

Golf Course: Huntingdale Golf Club is located in Victoria's wonderful sand belt area and is one of Australia's iconic golf courses and the original home of the Australian Masters. This is a course that continually rates as one of the best courses in Australia.

Tournament: The tournament will be a 54 hole stroke play event with the categories as follows:

All divisional categories are nett scores with the eligible players having a current and valid AGU handicap. Only 1 trophy per person with Tournament trophies taking precedence over divisional prizes.

In the event of a tie for the Overall Championship (Men – Ladies) there will be a sudden death playoff beginning on the 1st Hole. All other categories will be declared a tie.

Eligibility: Current membership of QAGA, Limbs 4 Life, SAAGA, AGNSW or WAADGA is required for participation in the tournament.

Entry deadline 19th February 2012.

Golf Handicap: There will be only be 1 nett champion and the winner may come from any of the Amputee Divisions. Only those who have a current and valid handicap. Proof of handicap will be requested to be provided at the event to be eligible.

- Refund Policy:** A full refund will only be given after a meeting of the AGA Committee and it is at the committee's sole discretion.
- Bag Storage:** Bag storage is available at Huntingdale Golf Club from the Monday to Friday. Clubs must be taken by players after the final round on Friday.
- Dress Code:** The dress code is designed to maintain an atmosphere consistent with the traditions of golf.
- Men are required to wear golf shirts with collars, and sleeves and either trousers or shorts with white socks and either golf shoes or neat enclosed runners.
- Women's shorts or golf skirts are to be of appropriate length. Slacks, shorts, golf shirts or sleeveless tops are permitted.
- No denim is allowed on the course.
